




RECOMMENDED COURSE STRUCTURES FOR COMMENCING STUDENTS

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INTRODUCTION

Dear commencing students,

Here are some important general guidelines of course selection for full-time students under the UNSW 3+ structure:

- Minimum 2 courses and maximum 3 courses per term. Generally speaking, it is not possible to choose more than 3 courses in a term.
- It's possible to choose only 1 course in a term but that is only applicable if you've exhausted your course selection options based on your UOC requirements and can only or only need to choose 1 course in a particular term. You will need to double check with and seek approval from [UNSW Student Services](#) in advance
- Minimum 8 courses for a total of three terms, which normally fall within 1 calendar year.
- It is possible to complete 9 courses in a full calendar year (3 courses per term from T1 to T3), but that also means you can only choose 7 courses in another year. Please double check with [UNSW Student Services](#) in advance.
- **Some courses are only available in certain terms** and some have **assumed prerequisites** that are not specified in the Handbook, so **it's important you follow the recommended structures to ensure optimal progression and course coverage**.
- All programs can be taken fully **online**. However, not all LING courses are offered online. Please check which ones are offered online before choosing your electives. **Note that online delivery still requires students to attend lectures and tutorials synchronously and fully participate in class.**

Below are the recommended course structures for commencing students in all programs. The recommended course structures are carefully constructed based on reasonable learning progression, UOC requirements as well as course availability. We strongly suggest you follow the recommended structures to ensure optimal learning progression and MODL course coverage. Alternative selections are possible but may result in less ideal progressions and missing out on certain MODL courses. If you would like to pursue alternative selections, please discuss it with the program convenor first before you proceed with it.
