## **UNSW Minerals and Energy Resources Engineering Scholarships – Commencing**

Value: \$15,000 per annum

Duration: Minimum duration of program

Program requirement: Be commencing full-time undergraduate study (single or double degree) in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Mining) at UNSW.

Value: \$15,000 per annum

Duration: Minimum duration of program

### **NSWMC Newcastle Mining Engineering Transfer Program**

Value: \$15,000 per annum

Duration: Remaining duration of program

Program requirement: Have successfully completed two years (160 credits) of a Bachelor of Engineering (Mining Transfer Program) at the University of Newcastle; and be commencing the third year of undergraduate study (single or double degree) in Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Mining) at UNSW.

### **Mitsubishi Rural Scholarship in Mining Engineering**

Value: \$15,000 per annum

Duration: Up to 5 years

Program requirement: Be commencing full-time undergraduate study (single or double degree) in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Mining) at UNSW and be a rural applicant.

### **Co-op Scholarship – Mining**

Value Mining Co-op: **\$13,625** per annum. UNSW Mining Engineering Co-op Program Scholars will be paid by the Sponsor Company whilst on industry training placement, at a rate equal to or above the prevailing minimum wage.

**Duration: 4 years**
