Applying to UNSW Bengaluru

Step 1: Ensure you are eligible

UNSW Bengaluru programs are open to Resident Indian Citizens, Non-Resident Indians and Overseas Citizens of India only for the first intake in 2026.

Step 2: Find your degree

Choose your program and make a note of the program code.

Step 3: Check entry requirements

Check that you meet the minimum academic and English language requirements of your chosen program. Some programs may also have special requirements. Visit unsw.to/apply-to-bengaluru

Step 4: Submit your application

Submit your application at our in-country events or via the UNSW Bengaluru website at unsw.edu.au/bengaluru. Applications open in March 2026.

Step 5: You will be notified of an outcome

Your application will be assessed as per the entry criteria. Applications and offers are prioritised according to academic merit and subject to program availability. You will receive an outcome by email once the assessment is complete.

Entry requirements

To gain entry to UNSW Bengaluru, you will need to meet both academic and English language requirements.

Assumed knowledge

There are no formal subject prerequisites for any of our degrees. Our degrees have 'assumed knowledge', which will help ensure you are off to a strong start in your first year. If you have not studied the assumed knowledge subjects, it will not prevent us from making you an offer.

Scholarships and awards

All Resident Indian Citizens automatically receive a tuition fee award of up to 10%, which is incorporated into the published fee rates. We also offer UNSW Bengaluru equity scholarships to support commencing undergraduate and postgraduate students experiencing financial hardship, helping them access a world-class education at UNSW Bengaluru.

UNSW Bengaluru offers two types of equity scholarships. Applications open in March 2026.

• UNSW Bengaluru Future Leaders Access Scholarship

A full tuition scholarship covers 100% of tuition fees for the full duration of the program. These are highly competitive and awarded to a small number of students.

• UNSW Bengaluru Progress Scholarship

A 35% reduction on tuition fees for the full duration of the program.

You must be a Resident Indian Citizen commencing a UNSW Bengaluru undergraduate or postgraduate program to apply for these equity scholarships. Applicants must have documented evidence to demonstrate their financial need in the application.

UNSW Bengaluru Fee Refund Policy

UNSW Bengaluru is committed to transparency and fairness in all financial matters. This Fee Refund Schedule is issued in compliance with the *University Grants Commission Notification on Fee Refund and Non-Retention of Original Certificates (2024)* (hereafter UGC Fee Guidelines).

1. Application fee refund
The application fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.
Applicants are advised to verify eligibility criteria, program details and deadlines prior to making payment.

2. Tuition deposit refund
A tuition deposit, paid at offer acceptance, shall be refundable on cancellation of admission by the student, and as per 3. Tuition fee refund.

3. Tuition fee refund
The refund of tuition upon withdrawal of admission shall be governed by the timelines specified below, as per UGC Fee Guidelines.

Time of withdrawal of admission	Percentage of refund of fees
15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission	100% (a deduction of an amount not more than 5% of the fees, subject to a maximum of INR 1000 as processing fees)
Within 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission	90%
Within 15 days after the formally notified last date of admission	80%
Between 16 to 30 days after the formally notified last date of admission	50%
After 30 days from the formally notified last date of admission	No refund

All eligible refunds will be processed within 15 working days from the date of receipt of a complete withdrawal application.

4. Mode of refund
Refunds will be processed within 15 working days of submission of the claim. All refunds shall be made directly to the bank account provided by the student at the time of withdrawal application. No refunds will be issued in cash. Refunds shall be processed only after the student submits a duly signed withdrawal request along with necessary documentation. All refunds under this UNSW Bengaluru Fee Refund Policy are to be made in INR unless otherwise arranged.
