Program and Course Terminology

Terminology	Definition
Specialisation Requirement	Students must complete 96 Units of Credit (UOC) (16 courses) in one of the following specialisations: Animation and Moving Image, Visual Arts, Art Theory, Music*
Core Courses	Students must complete 48 UOC (8 courses) of Core Courses.
Disciplinary Studios	Students must complete 36 UOC (6 courses) across two studio sequences of Level 1, Level 2 & Level 3 courses in two of the 6 studio areas.
Level 1 or 2 Art Theory Courses Students must complete 6 UOC (1 course) in Level 1 or Level 3 Art Theory Courses.	
Level 3 Art Theory Courses	Students must complete 6 UOC (1 course) in Level 3 Art Theory Courses.
Free Electives	Students must complete 36 UOC (6 courses) of Free Electives. A Free Elective is any course offered either within or outside UNSW Arts, Design and Architecture into which you can enrol.
General Education	Students must complete 12 UOC (2 courses) of General Education courses in line with UNSW General Education Rules.
Optional Minor	Students enrolled in the standalone program may opt to use their Free Elective courses to complete an optional minor. Courses completed as part of the disciplinary component cannot be double counted towards the minor.
Overall Program UOC	Students must complete a minimum of 144 UOC (24 courses) across Specialisation Requirement, Free Electives and General Education to fulfil program requirements.

Students admitted to the Bachelor of Fine Arts (Visual Arts or Animation and Moving Image) (BFA) who have completed one of the following TAFE diplomas under the following TAFE Creative Arts and Culture Training Package CUA are eligible for credit transfer.

- CUA51120 Diploma of Visual Arts

Students who have completed an Advanced Diploma (AQF Level 6) will be offered 60 UOC towards the BFA. This credit will be for:

- 1. <u>DART1100 Studio Art Practice 1</u> (Visual Arts specialisation) (6 UOC) or <u>DART1200 Digital Studio 1</u> (Animation & Moving Image specialisation) (6 UOC)
- 2. <u>DART1101 Studio Art Practice 2</u> (Visual Arts specialisation) (6 UOC) or <u>DART1201 Digital Studio 2</u> (Animation & Moving Image specialisation) (6 UOC)
- 3. General Education (12 UOC)
- 4. Free Elective (36 UOC)

Students who have completed a Diploma (AQF Level 5) will be offered 36 UOC towards the BFA. This credit will be for:

- 1. <u>DART1100 Studio Art Practice 1</u> (Visual Arts specialisation) (6 UOC) *or* <u>DART1200 Digital Studio 1</u> (Animation & Moving Image specialisation) (6 UOC)
- DART1101 Studio Art Practice 2 (Visual Arts specialisation) (6 UOC) or DART1201 Digital Studio 2 (Animation & Moving Image specialisation) (6 UOC)
- 3. General Education (12 UOC)
- 4. Free Elective (12 UOC)

Once this credit has been applied, students will have some terms with a lighter load of courses.
