Setting:	Bronx County, NY
Start Date:	1993
End Date:	Ongoing
Participants:	2000 individuals aged 70 or older (26% of whom are African American)
Assessment Schedule:	Annually
Measures:	Medical, neuropsychological, physical, and epidemiological data and assignment of clinical cognitive outcomes (dementia and subtype, amnesic or non-amnesic MCI) and significant life transitions (e.g., nursing home placement, death). Biological specimens are banked for current and future assays.
