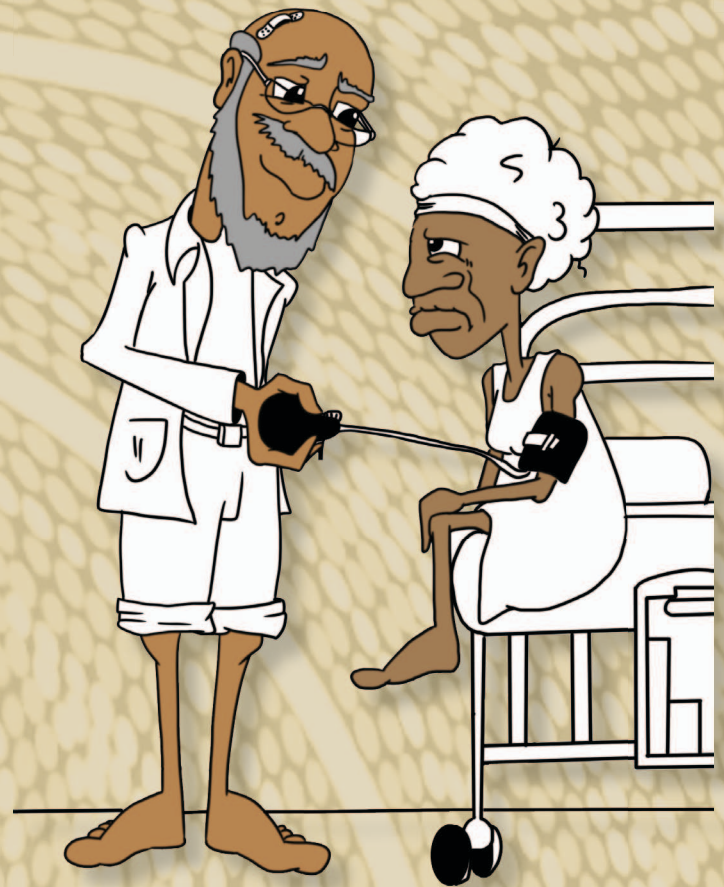


What is agitation?

- Often in the afternoon

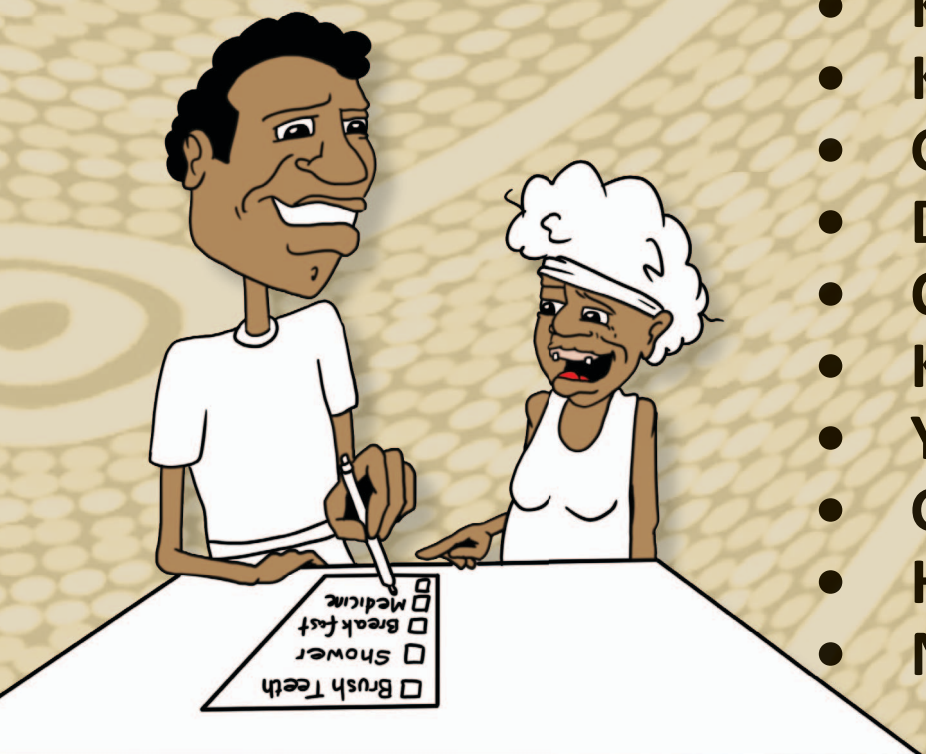
Why does it happen?
