


UNSW Academic GP Network Expression of Interest Research Projects Criteria

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What kind of research projects is the UNSW Academic GP Network looking for?

The UNSW Academic General Practice Network supports research that strengthens and innovates within general practice and primary health care settings. We welcome proposals that are collaborative, practice-based, and relevant to primary care clinicians, patients, and communities served by its members.

We are particularly interested in projects that focus on:

- 1. Health Services Research:** Exploring models of care, service delivery, access, equity, and integration across the health system.
- 2. Medical Education and Workforce Development:** Investigating teaching methods, supervision, training pathways, and strategies to support the future general practice workforce.
- 3. Cancer Care in Primary Care:** Improving prevention, screening, early detection, survivorship, end of life care and coordination of cancer care within general practice settings.

If your research aligns with these themes and contributes to the advancement of primary care, we encourage you to submit an EOI with our network.

Documentation Needed for Submission:

1) Research Proposal

Your research project description should include a statement of the research problem and its significance. You need to provide an outline of how you plan to address the problem.

2) Data Management Plan

Research Project Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clearly outlines aims, significance, and research question• Aligns with the UNSW Academic General Practice Network's Research aims and goals• Clear to lay audiences

Research Aim	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Aligns with the UNSW Academic General Practice Network's research how the project supports the network's aim and goals Clear to lay audiences Specific, measurable, and relevant to general practice
Literature Review	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Relevance to General Practice Clearly identified research gaps which are addressed by the project Demonstrates clear research in the field using high-quality sources Integrates findings to justify the proposed study
Research Question	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Define the research question: Ensure it is clear, focused, and answerable. Follows a clear layout e.g.PICOT, PEO, SPIDER
Research Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describes study design, population, methods, and analysis Includes feasibility, ethical considerations, and timeline.
Collaborators and Supervisors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lists confirmed or proposed team members Outlines roles, responsibilities, and institutional affiliations of team members Demonstrates meaningful input and active involvement from primary health care consumers and clinicians throughout the research process and project.
Ethics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identifies ethical risks and mitigation strategies Includes HREC approval status or plan Alignment with National Statement of Ethical Conduct in Human Research
Data Collection and Analysis Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Details data sources, tools, and analysis methods Complies with UNSW data governance and privacy policies Data Management Plan for proposed data collection
Funding and resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identifies current or potential funding sources Lists required resources (staff, software, infrastructure) Demonstrates feasibility within available support Applications must also articulate how they will support the practices, clinicians and patients who participate in the study

Monitoring reporting plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides a clear timeline with milestones for project completion • Includes progress tracking and reporting mechanisms • Outlines responsibilities for monitoring and evaluation
Dissemination Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describes how findings will be shared (e.g., publications, conferences) • Includes strategies for reaching clinicians, policymakers, and patients
Alignment with UNSW GP Network	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explicitly states how the project supports the network's aim, goals and research priorities • Demonstrates how the project will contribute financially and/or in-kind support to the UNSW Academic GP Network's research capacity, including skills development, infrastructure enhancement, and network-wide activities. • Includes collaboration with UNSW-affiliated practices or researchers (if applicable)
Capacity Building	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describes how the project supports GP research skills or infrastructure • May include training, mentoring, or practice engagement • Outlines how the project will contribute to shared infrastructure or resources that benefit the broader UNSW GP network?
