Symbols are widely used in healthcare and medical device packaging to convey crucial safety information, without relying on language.

We are researching the effectiveness of newly designed contact lens (CLs) and lens care product symbols, by comparing them to an approved medical device symbol. In developing universally understood symbols, we aim to promote compliant CLs wearing and reduce the risk of CLs related complications.

To do so, our study has developed an association test and we need **your** help!

The study involves a 15-20min in-person survey at the UNSW Optometry Clinic. You will be asked to match the given contact lens and lens care product symbols, to their intended meaning. All participants would be given a \$20 Coles E-card for their valuable time.

You must be:

- At least 18 years of age.
- Currently wearing contact lenses (soft or rigid)
- Speak English,
- Can read and write one of, Chinese, Japanese, German and Arabic.
- Participants who meet the following criteria will be excluded from the study:
- Not a current contact lens wearer.
- Under 18 years old
- Do not speak English
