

Appearance & Accessibility Features on Inspera

Inspera features 3 OPTIONS to alternate the test appearance and accessibility. Click the hamburger icon on the top right corner of your test page to access the options.







1. CONTRAST

Click Contrast and choose:

- Normal, or
- Inverted











2. TEXT SIZE

Click **Text Size** and choose:


- Regular, or

- Extra Large


3. TEXT-TO-SPEECH

This feature is **optional**. If it is available in your exam, you will see the notification like the one at the start of your test (image on the right).



If it is available, you **need to enable** it to function in your test. You will have **Text-To-Speech** in your options. Click it and choose **Enable Text to Speech**.







Text-to-speech only works when you are online.


Then, you will find a **Play button** that if you click, will play an audio of the text you selected on the page.
